

# C-DIT INVITES APPLICATION FOR EDUCATIONAL PARTNERSHIP FOR ITS I T COURSES

Centre for Development of Imaging Technology, C-DIT is an autonomous institution set up in 1988 by the Govt. of Kerala under the chairmanship of the Hon. Chief Minister engaged in Research and Development, Visual Communication, Image Processing, Information Technology and Training. C-DIT's goal is advancement of research, development and training in imaging technology with an implied role in socially relevant science & development communication.

**Technology Extension Team**, which taps the vast human resources of the State and help them translate their potential to bring about larger benefits for the State. Offering a rich gamut of courses in association with Educational Partners spread across the 14 districts is the main functional area of the Technology Extension Team. Having as many as 300 Partners, this Team holds the record for having the largest number of franchisees under any similar Government agency in the State. With this view, C-DIT wishes to expand its reach across the state through a partnership programme in IT education.

**Who can Apply ?** – Those who can invest in training space and have the necessary infrastructure for IT training. (*Please refer website for further details*). IT training institutions already offering such courses will be considered, if they are willing to set apart exclusive facilities for C-DIT approved courses. The details of CEP schemes and list of present CEP centres are available in the CEP link of C-DIT website

**The Selection Process** - Selected number of institutions which fulfill the prescribed requirements (refer CEP link of website [www.cdit.org](http://www.cdit.org)) will be approved as C-DIT Educational Partners (CEP) under this scheme. The number of CEPs will be initially limited to one, three and five in the Panchayath, Municipal and Corporation areas respectively. The registration of CEPs will be completed separately for each local body after a thorough screening process in three phases. The CEP registration shall be for a period of 4 years. .

C-DIT shall prepare the course material and scheme, set the standards, conduct the evaluation/tests and award the certificates. The fees to be collected from students will be shared between C-DIT and the CEP as per MOU to be signed.

The application forms in the prescribed format along with a processing fee (non-refundable) of Rs. 1000/- by DD drawn in favour of Registrar, C-DIT payable at Thiruvananthapuram should reach to the State Co-ordinator (CEP) before 20<sup>th</sup> April 2007.
